CHIEF NICK DINOVO:

- 1. With the bailout simulator bids due at the time of the meeting, I would like to schedule the construction with the bid winner as soon as possible. With that being said, I would also like to begin the process of relocating the equipment in storage out of that area and to a different location within the Mezzanine. This way we can start constructing the firefighting props and simulated bedroom. I would like to coordinate efforts with the Association and the Commissioners in order to move the equipment without impinging on anyone else's belonging.
- 2. Captain Meservey and Giguere were at the New York City Fire Academy last weekend for hands-on training. I would like to thank The Commissioners for supporting the training. It was a great opportunity for our Officers to experience training outside of the Town of Colonie at such a widely known facility.
- 3. The New York State Chiefs show is coming up in June, I believe there are a few members that are interested in attending. If it is OK with the Commissioners, would they be allowed to take department vehicles to Syracuse to attend the show?

The attendees at last year's New York State Association of Fire Chiefs (NYSAFC) Annual Conference & FIRE Expo used a department vehicle for travel to Syracuse. Attendees at this year's conference have Board approval to use a department vehicle.
